Liberty Transit

- Route to former Brewton Parker should extend to Liberty High School as a turn-around point
- There should be a stop at Dunlevie Rd and US 84 in Allenhurst
- When is transit coming to Allenhurst?

Proposed road projects

- The Hinesville bypass should not allow driveways [curb cuts] because if you allow one, everyone will want to have one and the investment in the road will be wasted.
- The bypass will cause people to not stop and spend money in Hinesville
- The bypass should primarily serve truck traffic
- US 84 in Hinesville should have sidewalks and bike lanes
- US 84 at Georgia Power should be a right in/right out only
- The widening of SR 119 will harm the canopy of historic oak trees. This should be a preservation corridor.
- There should not be a road [Allenhurst Connector] through the Miller Trust.
- The proposed road [Peacock Creek Loop] at Liberty High School will cause traffic issues because of the high school
- SR 144 on Fort Stewart has a lower speed limit during training activities and traffic backs up.
- The section of the bypass from US 84 in Long County to SR 119 should be built first to allow the mill workers to get to 119 and reduce truck traffic through Hinesville
- Elim Church Rd needs a traffic light as part of the safety project.
- There should be another connection to/from Hinesville south of Wal-Mart to the bypass
- Paving Walthourville Rd/S Arnold Dr will ease the congestion at US 84 and SR 57 in Ludowici due to schools and government building traffic having an alternative
- The industrial park in Long County needs a deceleration lane
- Trucks on Barrington Ferry are an issue
- Add right turn lane at US 84 and Airport Rd to Walthourville
